Dear Comrades,

13th all India Biennial Conference of UBIEU

In our Representative Council Meeting held at Digha last year, we finalised itineraries of Branch wise General Meetings, Region/State Conferences and 13th all India Biennial Conference.

It was decided that the Region/State Conferences are to be held between 1st June 2017 and 31st October 2017. Accordingly, many Region/State Committees have finalised dates of their Conferences and intimated to the CEC Office. We would like to advise all the Region/State Committees to fix their dates immediately who are yet to take decision in this regard so far.

The Representative Council also decided to hold the 13th All India Biennial Conference of UBIEU during the month of Nov-Dec 2017 and delegated the responsibility on Office Bearers at Head Quarters to settle the date and venue of all India Conference.

The office bearers stationed at Kolkata have decided to hold the Conference at Kolkata. Tentatively it has decided that the Conference will be held from 8-10 Dec 2017, subject to finalisation of the Auditorium. It has also been decided that the City (Kolkata) & the Auditorium (to be finalised) will be dedicated to two of our ex-Office Bearers deceased during the period, viz. Com Chinmoy Bhattacharjee and Com Ajay Guhas

A Reception Committee has been formed recently to look after the relevant affairs of the All India Conference ensuring its hassle free conduction. Prof. Dr Susnata Das (an eminent academician), Com Shyamal Chakraborty (our Joint Secretary) and Com Saurabh Sen Gupta has been selected as the Chairman, Secretary and Treasurer respectively. Some other Office Bearers were also selected. The list of the Office Bearers of the Reception Committee is appended. The Reception Committee will communicate the pertinent matters in due course. All are requested to reciprocate for smooth implementation of the affairs.

We are all aware of the escalating increment in prices of all commodities. During a Conference from arrival of the delegates to their departure huge activities are involved. We are also committed to provide the delegates and observers reasonable comfort during their stay in the city. We can easily assess that it will cost a substantial amount. We have faith on our members and it is our experience that whenever union gave calls the members responded spontaneously and overwhelmingly. We would request all our members to provide

maximum endeavour for collecting donations and advertisements from well wishers of our Union.

It has been tentatively decided that the Conference will be held from 8th to 10th December 2017. On 8th Dec 2017 afternoon, Inaugural Session will be held. Com Pradip Biswas, the General Secretary of Bank Employees Federation of India has consented to inaugurate the Conference. Other programme of the Inaugural session will be finalised in due course. The Delegate Session will be held on 9 - 10 Dec 2017. The name of the Auditorium will be informed after final booking.

Comrades, we are passing through a critical period.
